


#### SHARING OUR TREASURE

When Jesus first told his disciples what would happen to him in Jerusalem and they reacted with shock and horror, he told them that everyone who wished to follow him must also carry their own crosses. As Jesus was willing to carry his cross, shameful and horrible and lethal as it was, he calls upon us to carry our own painful and difficult crosses. Remember, the cross he carried was not for himself. He carried his cross for everyone else - for Peter and Judas; for revolutionaries crucified with him; for you and for me. We are called to carry crosses for others as well, to ease the burdens on our neighbor. As Jesus gave of himself for our benefit, we are called to give of ourselves for the benefit of those in need. We are challenged to see Jesus in our neighbor in need, for that makes clear to us that we are returning in some small way the debt we owe to him who gave his life for us.


