Will the seeds within us bloom and bear fruit? That depends on whether we nurture them well or not. Sometimes we let them dry out and die. Maybe we just don't pay attention to God's word and miss our opportunity or we fail to understand it; or we decide it doesn't relate to our own lives; or we don't allow it to penetrate deep into our hearts; or we reject it because it's too challenging. Like the seed in today's parable, there are many obstacles to God's seed bearing fruit. Let us pray in the hope that God's word in us can eventually bear abundant fruit.

#### **CONGRATULATIONS TO JESUS CALDERON**

Jesus Calderon, a parishioner of St. Joseph Church, won 1st place at the State Architectural Design event at the NJ High School State TSA (Technology Student Association) Conference at TCNJ on May 3, 2023. TSA holds this event annually for high school students to compete in over 35 different technology-related categories. This year's theme for Architectural Design was to design a senior assisted living facility. Jesus developed the plans, model, and documentation portfolio to bring home a 1st place trophy for Boonton High School, winning against other strong competitors throughout New Jersey. He competed at the 2023 TSA National Conference, June 28 - July 2, 2023 in Louisville, Kentucky and got in the Preliminary Round.

#### MARIAN PILGRIMAGE TO THE BASILICA

The Paterson Diocese is inviting local Catholics to take part in what promises to be a powerful spiritual experience: a Marian pilgrimage to the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington, D.C. in October. Participants have two options: a one-day pilgrimage on Saturday, October 14<sup>th</sup>, or an overnight, two-day pilgrimage, from Friday, October 13<sup>th</sup> to Saturday, October 14<sup>th</sup>.



All pilgrims will visit the impressive Byzantine and Romanesque basilica. They will attend Mass with Bishop Kevin J. Sweeney on his first diocesan pilgrimage as bishop and have the opportunity for confession in the Crypt Church. Pilgrims also can pray a multilingual rosary and Chaplet of Divine Mercy and enjoy quiet time in personal prayer. The basilica has more than 80 chapels and oratories.

The one-day experience will include bus transportation to Washington, D.C., from various parishes in the Paterson Diocese, leaving between 6 and 6:45 AM depending on the departure point. The cost is \$65 per person, which includes bus transportation, gratuities, and activities at the shrine.
