#### THE MOST HOLY BODY & BLOOD OF CHRIST (CORPUS CHRISTI)

#### First Reading: Genesis 14:18-20

Melchizedek, a priest of God, prayed that Abram would be blessed by God. He also praised God for delivering Abram's foes into his hands.

#### Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 11:23-26

Paul describes Jesus' actions during the last supper. Jesus broke bread and said it was his body given for us, asking that we do the same in remembrance of him. He then passed the cup and called it his blood. Jesus then asked us to break bread in this manner to remember his death until he returns.

#### Gospel: Luke 9:11b-17

Jesus spoke to a large crowd when his disciples asked that he dismiss the people to give them a chance to find food and lodging. Jesus asked the disciples to give the crowd something to eat, but they had only five loaves of bread and two fish. Jesus then blessed and distributed the food, which fed about 5,000 people. Twelve baskets were then collected from what was left over.

# RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

**First Holy Communion** – Children are required to complete 1<sup>st</sup> grade of Religious Education before they can enter into the 2<sup>nd</sup> grade of our program for First Holy Communion.

Registration for **new** students will also be taking place. Our program begins with Kindergarten and continues through Grade 6. If you have a child in **Kindergarten only**, the registration fee is \$30. A copy of their baptismal certificate is required for each new child registered. Families must be registered members of the parish when registering for the program.

cans (aluminum only) as you can drop off: soda cans, beer cans, etc. Please help the Knights help those of us in need.







"Then taking the five loaves and two fish, and looking up to heaven, he said the blessing over them, he broke them, and gave them to the disciples to set before the crowd. They all ate and were satisfied. And when the leftover fragments were picked up they filled twelve wicker baskets."

How would I have felt if I was in the crowd, listening and learning, and hungry? I sat down and observed Him taking and breaking, praying and blessing, and then gave to the disciples and they to the crowd. I reach out and gratefully accept this gift.

Take a minute and apply that scene to your presence at holy mass today. We are taught in the word and then watch, pray and listen as Jesus becomes truly present in the bread and wine – 'MY BODY... MY BLOOD.' NOT A SYMBOL BUT A REAL PRESENCE. Our faith focuses on His coming to me in the sacrament.

May I express my faith in His presence and reverently receive and consume the most important moment for Catholics.
